Walking in the Clouds ~ Duke's Nose and Hidden waterfall, Lonavala

On 2nd August 2026

Duke's Nose, also known as Nagphani is a prominent cliff and trekking destination near Lonavala, Maharashtra, named after the Duke of Wellington due to its resemblance to his nose. It offers stunning views of the Mumbai-Pune road and rail corridors, Khandala, and the Sahyadri peaks. The trek to the top is popular, especially during the monsoon season.

Trek difficulty level: Easy

Trek Schedule -

06:30 am - Start from Thane teen hath naka, pickups at Mulund, Koparkhairane

09:00 am - Reach Kurwande village, base, Lonavala, Enroute breakfast

09.30 am - Start trekking

10:30 am - Reach top and photography session

11:50 pm - Start descending and reach base village,

12.00 pm - Proceed to hidden waterfall nearby, fun at waterfall, Photography session,

01.00 proceed Lonavla for lunch,

01.30 pm to 02.30 pm - Lunch (Delicious Gujrathi Thali)

03.00 pm - Start return journey to Mumbai, Enroute tea and snacks

06:00 pm - Arrival at Mumbai.
